- You will be on the treadmill for this test with guidance from our Cardiac Sonographers and supervision by a Cardiologist.
- If you take regular cardiac medications please consult with your Doctor regarding these.

24 Hours Holter and Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitoring:

- Please **DO NOT** shower or bathe whilst wearing these
- Loose clothing and a comfortable bra is recommended for female patients.
- · Loose shirts or t-shirts are recommend for male patients.
- These devices will cease recording after 24 hours
